NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and the Deed of Gift. Rule A4 is modified as described in "Scoring" in this document.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Any and all advertising shall be in accordance with the SCIRA Advertising Prescription.

3. ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 This regatta is open to boats that are properly registered with SCIRA for the 2019 calendar Year and registered skippers in good standing for 2019.

4. REGISTRATION AND FEES

- **Skipper and Crew \$100 Includes 2 dinners by Dino BBQ, lunches, bevs, etc.**
- Extra Dinner \$25 per person, extra lunch, bevs \$10 per person

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 All boats shall have a valid Measurement Data Sheet on file with SCIRA and are subject to Measurement at any time at the reasonable discretion of the SCIRA Representative, or Race Committee.
- 6.2 All boats are required to have a current Class Decal properly displayed.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Regatta Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration Table in the NYC Clubhouse

8. COURSES

The courses will be “variant” per SCIRA Rules for Conducting Sanctioned Regattas, and are Attached to the Sailing Instructions.

9. SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A4 will apply. One race shall be completed to constitute a Regatta; after 6 races, one discard will be allowed.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk: see RRS4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitors' participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by laws.

By entering this event, you are agreeing to this Waiver and Release. Additionally, it is the responsibility of NYC Members/Guests to take appropriate measures to safeguard their personal property while on club premises.

11. PRIZES

Perpetual Trophy to the top skipper. Skipper is responsible for engraving and returning the trophy before the next year's Regatta.

Keeper trophies to the top 3 skippers and crews.
